- 09h30 Train departs Rovos Rail Station in Pretoria
- 13h00 Lunch is served as the train travels north through Warmbaths and Nylstroom
- 19h30 Dinner is served en route to the border at Beitbridge

DAY 2

- 07h00 Breakfast is served as the train travels through baobab country towards Bulawayo
- 13h00 Lunch is served
- 16h30 Tea is served
- 19h30 Dinner is served en route to Mpopoma for overnight

DAY 3

- 07h00 Breakfast is served in the dining cars. Depart Mpopoma
- 13h00 Lunch is served as the train travels along one of Africa's longest stretches of straight railway line – 114km
- 15h00 Arrive at Kennedy Siding for a game drive at The Hide
- 19h30 Dinner en route to Thompsons Junction for overnight

DAY 4

- 17h00 Breakfast is served until 09h30
Depart Thompsons Junction
- 10h00 Arrive in Victoria Falls

VICTORIA FALLS TO PRETORIA

DAY 1

- 17h00 Train departs Victoria Falls Station and travels towards Hwange National Park, Zimbabwe's largest reserve
- 19h30 Dinner is served en route to Kennedy Siding for the overnight stop

DAY 2

- 05h00 Early wake-up call with a continental breakfast
- 06h00 Disembark for a game drive at The Hide
- 11h00 Brunch is served as the train travels along one of Africa's longest stretches of straight railway line – 114km
- 19h30 Dinner is served en route to the border at Beitbridge

DAY 3

- 07h00 Breakfast is served as the train leaves baobab country
- 13h00 Lunch is served as the train crosses the Tropic of Capricorn towards Warmbaths and Nylstroom
- 19h30 Dinner is served as the train passes the edge of the escarpment

- 07h00 Breakfast is served until 09h30
- 10h00 Arrive in Pretoria





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VICTORIA FALLS | PRETORIA - 4 NIGHTS

DAY 1

- 17h00 Depart from Victoria Falls Station, Zimbabwe. Guests may freshen up in their suites before joining fellow travellers in the lounge car or observation car at the rear of the train.
- 19h30 Dinner is served in the dining cars en route to Malindi. *Dress: Formal*
Please ensure the Train Manager or Administration Deputy is in possession of your passport.

DAY 2

- 05h00 A continental breakfast is served in the dining cars until departure.
- 06h00 Enjoy a game drive at The Hide in Hwange National Park.
- 12h00 Lunch is served in the dining cars. The train travels between Dete and Gwaai along one of the world's longest stretches of straight railway line – 114 kilometres – and passes Bulawayo: second city of Zimbabwe, capital of Matabeleland and industrial capital of the country.
- 16h30 Tea is served in the lounge and observation cars.
- 19h30 Dinner is served in the dining cars en route to Mbalabala. *Dress: Formal*

DAY 3

- 07h00 Breakfast is served in the dining cars until 10h00. The train departs for Gwanda.
- 08h30 The train stops at Gwanda where guests have an opportunity to stroll through the village.
- 10h30 Travel south through baobab country to Beitbridge for Zimbabwean border formalities.
- 13h00 Lunch is served in the dining cars.
- 16h30 Tea is served in the lounge and observation cars. The train crosses the Limpopo River to Musina for South African border formalities.
- 19h30 Dinner is served en route to Louis Trichard. *Dress: Formal*

DAY 4

- 07h00 Breakfast is served in the dining cars until departure. The train crosses the Tropic of Capricorn.
- 09h00 Transfer to The Ranch Conservancy. Explore the game and prolific birdlife of this 1000ha ranch followed by lunch.
- 14h00 Return to the train.
- 16h00 Tea is served in the lounge and observation cars. Travel through Nylstroom and Warmbaths. Pass the edge of the escarpments where the Highveld drops precipitously.
- 19h30 Dinner is served in the dining cars en route to Pyramid. *Dress: Formal*

DAY 5

- Please ensure that your luggage is ready for collection at 09h45 and that you have your passport.
- 07h00 Breakfast is served in the dining cars until 09h30.
 - 10h00 Arrive at journey's end at Rovos Rail Station, Pretoria.
