The Hopper: This brief “hop” leaves the V&A Waterfront and flies via the city bowl, Green Point Stadium, Clifton, Camps Bay and the majestic Twelve Apostles.

Chapmans Peek: A continuation of The Hopper flight via the Atlantic seaboard continuing on to view Llandudno, Hout Bay, Chapman’s Peak and sights of the Southern Peninsula.

Table Mountain 360: This spectacular flight continues from the Chapman’s “Peek” Flight via impressive Chapman’s Peak, Noordhoek beach, Fish Hoek, Kalk Bay, Muizenberg and the lush Constantia Valley - South Africa’s oldest wine region and home to Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens.

Cape Point Tour: Detour from the Table Mountain 360° via Kommetjie, Scarborough, Cape Point Nature Reserve, the sweeping crags of Cape Point and Simon’s Town. You could be very lucky with some seasonal whale spotting!
